

Downloading MP3 files through Blackboard

You have two options:

- **RealPlayer**

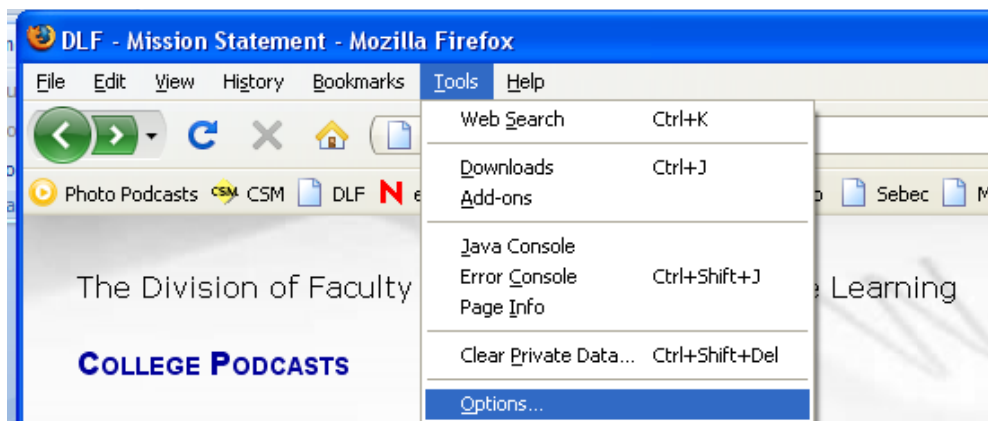
Use RealPlayer (<http://www.real.com/realplayer>) media player to save internet audio and video with a one-click download button. The Web Download feature identifies embedded audio and videos on websites such as YouTube, and Blackboard. A download button appears near each available audio or video. Use the button to quickly download and save the videos directly to the My Library "Downloads & Recordings" category for viewing anytime, even offline. See the direction at the RealPlayer website:

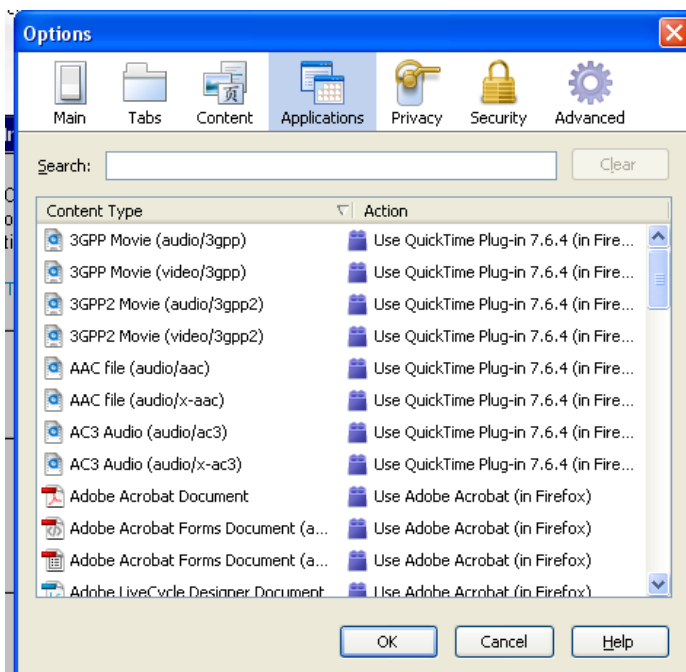
- **Firefox**

Use Mozilla Firefox (www.mozilla.com/firefox/) web browser and changing your browser settings as described below:

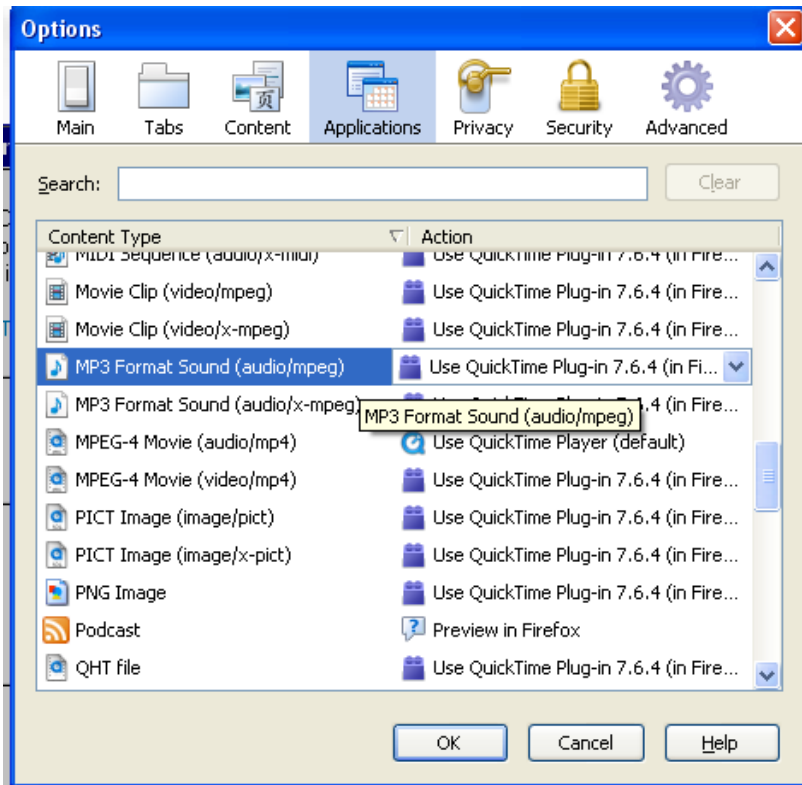
1. Start Firefox and, under the Tools menu, select Options.



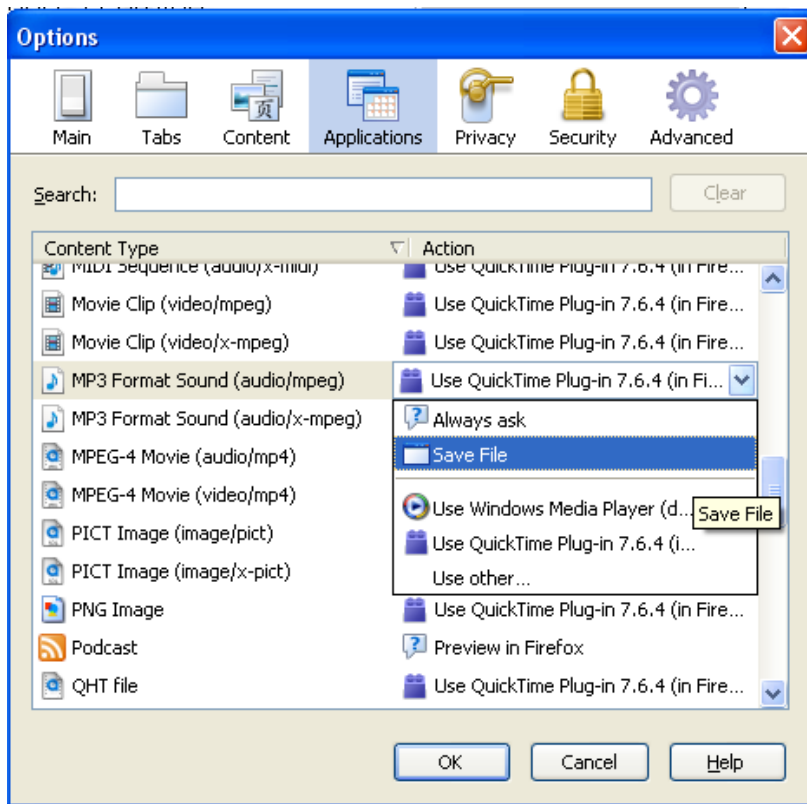
2. Select the Applications tab at the top of the Options dialog screen.



3. Scroll down to the Content Type (MP3 Format Sound (audio/mpeg)).



4. Select the selection box under Action, and click on Save File. Press O.K.



The next time you click on a link to an MP3 file in Blackboard, you should see Firefox's Download Manager open. This will display the progress of the download. When the download is complete you can click on the "open" hyperlink to play the clip or open it from the download folder.
